Car Parking, Traffic Processes, Drop off/Pickup

Information for Parents/Caregivers

No car parking is available on site for parents/caregivers. Parents are requested to take advantage of street parking areas around the School if wishing to accompany their children into the school grounds or collect them from their classrooms at the end of the day or during the school day.

There are pedestrian crossings on Partridge and Pier Streets. We encourage families to use these, and to obey the instructions of the trained road crossing monitors and SPW staff when on duty.

Consider the safety of other children as well as your own.

Staff are on duty until 3.45pm. Planning your pickup time to avoid the 3.15-3.30pm rush is advised.

Local council and street parking

SPW has been advised that the Holdfast Bay Council closely monitor the parking situation around the school, particularly on Partridge and Pier Streets, and fines may be imposed for incorrect parking. Note particularly the times of the No Standing zone on Pier St adjacent to the ELC.

SPW encourages families to consider parking a block or two away from the school and walk to school with students (as appropriate to their age), encouraging physical activity and independence.

Please note that some local residents have been advised by Council to place their rubbish bins along the road side of the curb for collection. Parents/caregivers are asked not to move these bins.

Partridge Street "Kiss & Drop" Zone

To make this area safer, parents/caregivers and students are asked to follow these steps when using the Partridge Street entrance and drop-off area during the hours of 8.00am and 4.30pm (which includes picking up from OSHC and from after sport/arts practices after school):

- Follow instructions of SPW staff on duty at all times.
- Place the school-issued Family Name Card on the back of your sun visor or on your dashboard so it can
 be seen by SPW staff as your car enters the gate. (If you do not have a Family Name Card, please write
 your family surname clearly on a sheet of paper. Front Office are able to issue new cards upon request.)
- Enter the Partridge Street car park as left turn only from Partridge Street (at all times).
- Avoid straddling the bike lane and footpath when entering Partridge Street (hence avoiding traffic
 infringements). Avoid blocking the flow of traffic on Partridge Street. If there is no clear entry to the SPW
 car park, continue ahead on Partridge Street and loop around the block.
- SPW staff will read your Family Name Card and gather your child/ren to be ready for collection if they are at Chapel steps. Keep driving forward and park as far along the yellow zone as possible, to allow traffic to continue moving.
- Exit Partridge Street gates making a left turn only.
- Stay in car and keep moving if child is not present. This may mean you have to exit the carpark and loop around the block.
- If there is insufficient space for your car to loop, please exit the SPW carpark and drive around the block to avoid blocking the exit for other cars.
- Do not get out of your car your child is to get in the car as quickly and safely as possible. Should your child not be able to manage this (including putting on their own seat belt), then please park on the street and walk in to collect your child.
- DO NOT PARK AND WAIT IN THE KISS AND DROP ZONE.
- The pickup zone is marked yellow and is a 30-second Kiss and Drop zone only. Cars are not to be left



unattended in this area. This includes after-school sport.

- Instruct your children to stay on the Chapel steps and watch for your car, so they are ready to be picked
 up from this yellow zone. They also need to listen carefully to staff on duty as they call family names to
 come forward.
- Move car forward as far as possible should further spaces become available in front of you.
- Children should not be picked up if your car is on the blue rotating line.
- Please observe the car park markings for Disabled, Visitors, Staff, and Loading Zone parks.
- Be aware of those parked in the car park wishing to reverse out and exit.
- When dropping off students, move as far forward along the yellow zone as possible before stopping, in order to allow other cars to enter the carpark area.
- Consider delaying your arrival time, to allow your child/ren time to get to Chapel steps. Students sometimes need this additional time to pack up, speak with teacher/s, and get to the pickup area. Remember the yellow zone is a 30-second wait area only.
- The above processes are also to be followed when collecting children from after-school sport or rehearsals. Do not leave cars unattended in the yellow area or in parks marked "staff" or "loading zone".

Staff members are instructed to monitor this area and ask drivers who are not following the steps above to do so.
