Year 2 – Year 3 Transition Program

Warm Up - Session 1

In the "Warm Up" session, students will have the opportunity to meet with Kerry Ramsay, the Head of Primary, who will start to talk about their transition to Year 3. Additionally, students will enjoy a special playtime, where they can explore the primary play areas.

This session will take place on Monday morning of Week 3

On the Grid - Session 2

As children progress into their primary years many new and exciting opportunities open up for them allowing them to thrive in their educational journey. During the 'On The Grid' session, Year 3 teachers will visit the Year 2 students in the familiarity of their classrooms to share information about things they can look forward to in Year 3.

This session will take place on Tuesday morning of Week 3

Pit Stop - Session 3

In the 'Pit Stop' session, the children will enjoy the familiarity of their existing classmates and embark on a journey to discover the Year 3 learning spaces. Each Year 2 class will have the opportunity to visit and spend time with one of the current Year 3 teachers. A thoughtfully crafted learning experience will allow the children to begin to become comfortable with the Year 3 learning environment.

These sessions will take place over the course of Week 5

Home Straight - Session 4

In the 'Home Straight' session the four Year 2 classes will be mixed and divided into 3 classes. Each of these groups will have the opportunity to spend a session with one of our current Year 3 teachers. In this session, children will participate in a specially crafted activity that centres on the theme of transition and how to approach change with a positive and growth-oriented mindset. This engaging experience aims to prepare them for the journey ahead with confidence and optimism.

This session will take place on Monday morning of Week 7

Chequered flag – Session 5

The 'Chequered Flag' session takes place on Moving On day. There will be much anticipation as we approach the Chequered Flag as children discover which teacher they will have in 2024 and which other students they will have in their class. This session serves as the initial step in building connections, allowing teachers and students to start getting to know one another in preparation for their upcoming journey into Primary schooling next year.
